



Guidelines for Hosting a Mama or Papa Dog

Hosting a Papa Dog

- Live within 45 minutes of PAWS Headquarters.
- The Breeding Dog must be under control on leash or long line at all times, unless in a fenced in area.
- The Breeding Host home and Breeding Male must attend scheduled Breeding Host meetings.
- The PAWS Veterinarian provides services at no cost to the volunteer. The volunteer is responsible for providing heartworm and flea/tick medicine, which can be purchased at cost through PAWS.
- You agree to feed PAWS approved diet and maintain proper weight and exercise for the Breeding Male.
- You agree to provide transportation for the Breeding Male to PAWS Headquarters for breeding or Veterinary Care.

Hosting a Mama Dog

- Live within 1 ½ hours of PAWS Headquarters.
- The Breeding Dog must be under control on leash or long line at all times, unless in a fenced in area.
- The Breeding Host home and Breeding Female must attend scheduled Breeding Host meetings.
- The PAWS Veterinarian provides services at no cost to the volunteer. The volunteer is responsible for providing heartworm and flea/tick medicine, which can be purchased at cost through PAWS.
- You agree to feed PAWS approved diet and maintain proper weight and exercise for the Breeding Female.
- You agree to notify the Breeding Department every time the female comes into season.
- You agree to provide transportation for the Breeding Female to PAWS Headquarters for breeding or Veterinary Care.
